Questions concerning the solicitation must be submitted in writing to the Contracting Officer. All Offerors are strongly encouraged to attend the pre-submittal briefing.

STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS RECEIPT/LOCATION: Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) will be received until Noon local time on April 24, 2006 at the METRO Office of Procurement Plan Room, 2nd Floor, 1900 Main Street, Houston, Texas 77002. The SOQ (original and 20 hard copies in three ring binders), along with one electronic copy in PDF format on a read only CD, are to be submitted in a sealed box bearing the name and address of the Offeror and the identification "Request for Qualifications No. RQ0600007". SOQ's received after the date and time will not be opened. There is a limitation of fifty (50) pages for the SOQ. The required forms and example documents shall not count towards the page limit, and the Offeror may also include Additional Information in an appendix to the SOQ that will not count towards the page limit.

METRO has recently implemented a new small business enterprise and disadvantaged business enterprise (SBE/DBE) program for businesses interested in providing goods and/or services to METRO.
